GEOGRAPHY

OVERALL AIM: Through our Geography curriculum we aim to develop pupils' knowledge and skills while inspiring a curiosity for the world they live in. Through teaching about diverse places, people and resources we aim to increase our pupils' understanding of human and physical geography while fostering a sense of awe, wonder and respect for our shared planet. Teaching is meaningful and relevant to a pupil's cognitive and physical ability. Learning tasks are differentiated to ensure the challenge is appropriate and achievable.

ACADEMIC

Pupils have opportunities to work independently and cooperatively in pairs and small groups. Pupils are encouraged to get curious and ask questions. They listen to and consider others' points of view, and broaden their understanding of the world beyond their local experience. They understand how Geography relates to their lives.

Pupils develop map skills, fieldwork skills and research using a variety of sources.

They analyse, interpret and evaluate qualitative and quantitative information. Pupils develop an understanding and use of Geography specific vocabulary and mathematical skills to support their studying.



SOCIAL

Pupils feel confident in their ability to contribute, respect each other, develop tolerance and empathy and develop a local and global identity.
